About This Program

The Bachelor of Business Administration in International Business - Russian is a dual concentration program requiring specific international business course work and 26 to 29 hours of coursework in the Russian language.

Competencies

- 1. Upon completion, IB Russian students will demonstrate knowledge of how to apply business management and analysis skills to business decisions in an International context with a focus on the Russian economy.
- Upon completion, IB Russian students will demonstrate a working knowledge of Business Statistics including the ability to interpret, critique, and estimate empirical models of business decision making.
- 3. Upon completion, IB Russian students will demonstrate a mastery of the Russian language and be able to apply it on a daily basis in a business context.
