

Post-Baccalaureate Certificate in Entrepreneurship

About This Program

The Post-Baccalaureate Certificate in Entrepreneurship provides students with skills and training in: identifying innovations and market opportunities, writing a business plan, obtaining funding, and launching a new company. The certificate enhances a student's general education, academic major and/or career preparation in innovation and entrepreneurship. All students will take a common course that will present the fundamentals of entrepreneurship.

Two additional courses will be taken, based on the students' interests, drawn from a list of approved courses across academic disciplines.

The certificate requires a total of nine semester credit hours of coursework, which can be completed in conjunction with an existing master's or PhD degree in any field or independently as a special student.

Competencies

1. Upon completion students will be able to identify business opportunities and access market needs.
2. Upon completion students will be able to apply critical thinking, adaptability to navigate uncertainty in making business decisions.
3. Upon completion students will be able to demonstrate knowledge and understanding of translating ideas into actionable business strategies.

Admissions Criteria

- Graduate students in good standing at UT Arlington may complete the certificate.
- Students not enrolled in a graduate program (special, certificate only students) must present for admission:
 - a bachelor's degree from an accredited university, and
 - a GPA of 3.0 for last 60 hours of undergraduate coursework.
