Admissions Criteria

For students in the MSW program at the time of enrollment for the Certificate, the Admission requirement will be to be in good standing, as defined by the MSW program, which includes having a GPA of 3.0 or higher. For non-degree seeking students who wish to enroll in the Certificate Program, a bachelor's degree in Social Work or a bachelor's degree and two-years of related professional experience, with a GPA of 3.0 or higher is required.
